Our Purpose



YouScience

ouScience – Don't Miss this Opportunity to Connect your Business to Students!

Through the work of the Sandusky County Business Advisory Council that is put on by the SCEDC and the North Point Educational Service Center, five of our Sandusky County School Districts are now subscribed to a new resource to help connect our labor pool to our local Sandusky County companies through the platform – YouScience. Now, for the first time, companies are being permitted to register on the YouScience system, making your company more visible to high school students! The Employer Connection Portal is a platform to assist Sandusky County students to become aware and better understand the businesses in our community.

YouScience is an aptitude-based career guidance tool being used by our Sandusky County School Districts to help students identify best-fit careers. This assessment is not just a career interest-based assessment like what has typically been used in the past.
